

## Covid-19 Cleaning Protocol

- Cleaning and disinfecting are a standard practise to ensure safe operation
- Procedures for increasing the frequency of cleaning and disinfecting of high traffic areas and common areas will be implemented
- High touch areas will include light switches, door handles/knobs, handrails surface counters, chairs, benches, cash register, equipment (rock handles, brooms, scoreboard numbers, measure stick)
- Proper cleaning supplies for hard surface and hand sanitizing will be provided and will be placed in prominent areas (Health Canada approved for use against Covid -19)
- Cleaning to be done to remove visible soiling
- Disinfecting to be done to kill germs on a surface
- Some areas/items may need 2-step with both cleaning and disinfection
- Use of cleaning products according to direction labels to disinfect properly
- PPE (Personal Protective Equipment) one-time use masks and gloves will be provided for cleaning purposes
- Perform hand hygiene before and after mask and glove use
- Cleaning supplies will be stored in a locked location (to be determined)
- Cleaning to be done after completion of all league games, with periodic deep cleaning as required
- Training will be provided to ensure use of cleaning product safely and instructions on areas responsible to clean
- Once cleaning procedures are completed sign off on log sheet located on the bulletin board in the viewing area
- Volunteers will be required for cleaning duties
- Lobby/Viewing areas to be cleaned: tables, chairs, benches, light switches, door handles
- Lounge/Bar area to be cleaned: cash register, bar surface, counter surface, tables, chairs, light switches, door handles/knobs
- MSDS (Material Safety Data Sheet) if required will be posted with cleaning supplies informing of potential hazards and how to work safely with chemical products. Follow prevention and first aid measures on the MSDS.
